Discriminators:

DGG subsidiaries have unique benefits that set them apart from other companies including:

- As a Tribal entity, DGG subsidiaries are certified SDBs, offering subcontract advantages.
- SDB and Native American credits are available with DGG subsidiaries as a Prime Contractor.
- 8(a) subsidiaries are exemption from \$3.5M threshold for services contracts.
- 5-year direct-source awards up to \$100M can be made to 8(a) DGG subsidiaries.
